The Estuary Trust, legally known as the Avon-Heathcote Estuary Ihutai Trust, was established in 2003. It is a community-based organisation that works closely with mana whenua, the city council and the regional council.

As well as being an active advocate for estuarine protection and improvement, the Trust oversees five ecological restoration projects on the estuary edges. We lead the renown annual Farewell to the Godwits and have been a key leader in the Christchurch's Mother of All Clean Ups.

What you will do

Manage ecological restoration projects – liaise with council parks staff, recruit and supervise volunteers.

Organise and manage community events such as the annual Farewell to the Godwits, Estuary Fest, presentations by researchers and the Trust's AGM.

Promote the work of the Trust through presentations, displays, newspaper articles, facebook and the website.

Manage the Trust's business affairs (dealing with correspondence and phone calls, organising monthly board meetings, preparing funding submissions, basic book-keeping, etc).
